Jagan Prasad Rawat (1904 -1990) Freedom Fighter and Minister in U.P. State Government

Born on August 18, 1904 at village Kagarol, District Agra; edu., primary education in a village school, left school in 1920-21 during the Non Cooperation Movement, resumed studies from D.A.V. College, Ajmer, LLB, Agra College; actively participated in the boycott of Simon Commission, accompanied Mahatma Gandhi (for two weeks) during his stay at Agra (1929), imprisoned in 1930, 1931, 1932, 1933, 1934, 1940, 1941 and 1942 (with gaps) and was released in 1945; career, Secretary, District Congress Committee, Agra, 1929-1934. Whip and Joint Secretary, Congress Party, 1937-1939, Member, Provincial Congress Committee, 1930-1951, elected Member of Legislative Assembly, United Province Legislative Assembly, 1937, Member, First Standing Committee of the Newspaper Editors' Conference, 1940 and Prantiya Rakshak Dal in Uttar Pradesh, 1942-1946, Parliamentary Secretary, 1946, left Congress Party along with Rafi Ahmad Kidwai, July 1951, returned to Congress Party, October 1951, Deputy Minister (for Agriculture and Police, Uttar Pradesh), 1952-1955 and 1955-1957, sent to Russia and other European countries along with the Indian Agricultural Delegation, 1954, General Secretary, UPCC, 1958-1960, Member, All India Consumers Cooperatives, 1960, Cabinet Minister (for Home, Agriculture, Industry and Independent Charge, U.P. State Government), 1962-1974, and Member, Agrarian Reform Committee, Zamindari Abolition Committee, All India Land Development Bank, etc. He died in 1990.

Rani Saroj Gaurihar(1929-)

Freedom Fighter and Hindi Literateur

Daughter of Jagan Prasad Rawat and Satyawati Rawat was born on November 4, 1929 in Agra; edu., MA, LLB, DPA (Diploma in Public Administration); along with her parents participated in demonstrations followed by the Quit India Movement and imprisoned for six months, 1943; married, Shri Pratap Singh Bhudev, Prince of Gaurihar - a Princely State, Madhya Pradesh, 14 February 1955; career, Member (Independent MLA), 1967 and Joint Secretary, M.P. Women Congress, 1967, President, Akhil Bharatiya Braj Sahitya Parishad, 1968, Trustee Member, Sangeet Kala Kendra, Agra, Nagari Pracharni Sabha, Agra, Gandhi Ashram Foundation Trust, Udyan Sharma Foundation Trust, Mahakavi Neeraj Foundation Trust, and Rafi Ahmad Kidwai Inter College Kagarol, Agra; Awards, Manas Sangam (Kanpur), 1989, Braj Sahitya Samman, 2009, Nagari Pracharni Sabha (Agra), 2007, Ratandeep Sanskritik Sanstha Vishisht Samman, 2004, etc.
