Vijaya Lakshmi Pandit (1900-1990)

Vijaya Lakshmi Pandit, a veteran freedom fighter and a distinguished diplomat was born at Allahabad in 1900 as the daughter of Motilal Nehru. She was educated privately; joined Civil Disobedience movement, 1931 and was imprisoned thrice, 1931, 1941 and 1942; elected to the Allahabad Municipal Board and was Chairman of its Education Committee for two years; Minister of Local Self-Government and Health, U.P. Govt., 1937-39 and 1946-47; President, All India Women's Conference, 1940-42 and Vice President, Women's International League for Peace and Freedom; member, Constituent Assembly, 1946, Lok Sabha, 1952-54 and 1964-68. She made an extensive tour of USA and attended the Pacific Relations Conference as leader of the delegation appointed by the Indian Council of World Affairs, 1944-45; led an "unofficial" delegation to the San Francisco Conference of the United Nations, 1945. She was delegate to the UNO in 1946, 1947, 1948, 1950 and 1963; was the first woman President of the UN General Assembly, 1953-54; India's Ambassador to USSR, 1947-49, USA, 1949-52 and Mexico, 1949-51; She was also the Ambassador to Ireland, 1955-61, to Spain, 1958-61 and concurrently High Commissioner to U.K., 1955-61; Governor of Maharashtra, 1962-64; awarded "Padma Bhushan", 1962; died on 2 December 1990.

Her published books are: *So I Became a Minister*, *The Evolution of India* and her autobiography *The Scope of Happiness*.

Bio-data

Ranjit Sitaram Pandit (1892-1944)

A freedom fighter and a great Sanskrit scholar; he was born at Rajkot (Kathiawar); educated at Rajkot and Junagardh and proceeded to England to qualify for the Bar; on his return to India, he was admitted as an advocate at Calcutta High Court, later went over to Rajkot and then to the Allahabad High Court; married Vijaya Lakshmi in 1921; under the influence of Nehru family and Gandhiji he took part in the national liberation struggle - Non-Cooperation, Civil-Disobedience and Quit India movements; Secretary, U.P. Provincial Congress Committee and acted as the Secretary of the Peshawar Enquiry Committee; imprisoned several times between 1921 to 1942; his health deteriorated during his last imprisonment in Bareilly Central Jail from where he was released on health grounds and soon died in January 1944 at Lucknow.

Some of the important Sanskrit works which he translated into English are: 'Rajatarangini', 'Ritu Samhara' and 'Mudra Rakshasa'.

A prolific writer, Navantara has published two volumes of her autobiography *Prison and Chocolate Cake* and *From Fear Set Free* and six novels. She has also written *Indira Gandhi: Her Road to Power*. She is the recipient of Sinclair Prize for Fiction, 1985; and the Commonwealth Prize (Eurasia), 1986 for her book *Plans For Departure*.

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BIO-DATA

VIJAYA LAKSHMI PANDIT (1900-1990)

Vijaya Lakshmi Pandit, a veteran freedom fighter and a distinguished diplomat was born at Allahabad in 1900 as the daughter of Motilal Nehru. She was educated privately; joined Civil Disobedience movement, 1931 and was imprisoned thrice, 1931, 1941 and 1942; elected to the Allahabad Municipal Board and was Chairman of its Education Committee for two years; Minister of Local Self Government and Health, U.P. Govt., 1937-39 and 1946-47; President, All India Women's Conference, 1940-42 and Vice-President, Women's International League for Peace and Freedom; member, Constituent Assembly, 1946, Lok Sabha, 1952-54 and 1964-68. She made an extensive tour of USA and attended the Pacific Relations Conference as leader of the delegation appointed by the Indian Council of World Affairs, 1944-45; led an "unofficial" delegation to the San Francisco Conference of the United Nations, 1945. She was delegate to the UNO in 1946, 1947, 1948, 1950 and 1963; was the first Woman President of the U.N. General Assembly, 1953-54; India's Ambassador to USSR, 1947-49, USA, 1949-52 and Mexico, 1949-51; She was also the Ambassador to Ireland, 1955-61, to Spain, 1958-61 and concurrently High Commissioner to U.K., 1955-61; Governor of Maharashtra, 1962-64; awarded "Padma Bhushan", 1962; died on 2 December, 1990.

Her published books are: *So I Became a Minister, The Evolution of India* and her autobiography *The Scope of Happiness*.
