N.Krishnaswamy (1924-2003)

N. Krishnaswamy, veteran Gandhian, was born on 17 July 1924 at Chennai; was arrested for participating in the Quit India movement in February 1943; joined Acharya J.B Kripalani as his Secretary in 1946 and continued till 1982; assisted Sucheta Kripalani in relief and rehabilitation work, 1947; after Gandhiji's death, set up the Secretariat of Gandhi National Memorial Fund under programmes for foreign students in India Universities through the Indian Council of Youth, 1957-62; travelled across several countries of Asia and Africa coordinating activities of youth organizations and social welfare bodies and worked in close collaboration with UN agencies; was successively Honorary General Secretary of the Gandhi an constructive work through voluntary agencies centering round the Youth development in rural sector; actively associated with Rural Workers' Trust; was also the Honorary General Secretary, Center Relief Committee (India) and the Sucheta Smarak Nidhi (New Delhi); he died on 25 August 2003.

J.B. Kripalani (1888-1982)

Veteran Gandhian, freedom fighter and parliamentarian; he was born at Hyderabad, Sind; studied at Hyderabad, Bombay, Karachi and Poona; Professor, Greer Bhumihar Brahman College Muzaffarpur, 1912-17 and Banaras Hindu University, 1919-20; participated in the Champaran Satyagraha, 1917; Vice-Principal, Kashi Vidyapith, 1921-22; Principal, Gujarat Vidyapith, Ahmedabad, 1922-27; General Secretary, Indian National Congress, 1934-46, and its President, 1946-47; Member, Constituent Assembly, 1946-50, and Provisional Parliament, 1950-52; resigned from the Congress and formed the Kisan Mazdoor Party, 1951; Member, Lok Sabha, 1953-57, 1957-62, 1963-67, and 1967-70. His publications include: *The Gandhian Way*, *The Latest Fad*, *The Non-Violent Revolution*, etc.
