# **Bio-Data Princess Indira of Kapurthala (1912-1979)**

#### **BBC Broadcaster**

Known as Maharaj Kumari Indira Devi (in India) and Princess Indira (in London) was born on 26 February, 1912 to Maharaja Paramjit Singh and Maharani Brinda of Kapurthala; edu., Queen Mary's College, Lahore, Punjab; career, left India for Britain in 1935 at the age of twenty-three, studied at the Royal Academy of Dramatic Art (RADA), London, managed to work briefly with Alexander Korda at London Film, successfully passed the St. John Ambulance examination after the outbreak of the Second World War and drove motor ambulances during air raids, worked as a postal censor, joined the BBC, 1942, known as the 'Radio Princess', hosted a halfhour radio programme in Hindustani for Indian forces stationed in the Middle East and the Mediterranean, broadcast the programme 'The Debate Continues', a weekly report to India on the proceedings in the House of Commons (where she was the only woman in the Press Gallery), broadcast many talks series for the Indian Section of the Eastern Service Division and broadcast on the Home Service, was offered а permanent contract with the Overseas Service Division, 1943, and continued to work for the BBC until 1968. She died in Ibiza, Spain in September 1979
