BIO-DATA

P. N. HAKSAR

Born on 4th September 1913 at Gujranwala, Punjab (now in Pakistan); was an eminent lawyer, diplomat and scholar; son of Jagat Narain Haksar and Dhanraj Haksar; he was educated at Allahabad and London; called to the Bar; practised at the Allahabad High Court. He was officer on Special duty, Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India, 1947; Adviser and later Alternative Chairman, Neutral Nations Repatriation Commission, Korea, 1953-54; Director, External Publicity Division, Ministry of External Affairs, 1955-58; Joint Secretary, Ministry of External Affairs, 1959-60; High Commissioner to Nigeria, 1960; Ambassador to Dahomey and Togo; 1962-64; Ambassador to Austria, 1964-68; Deputy High Commissioner and Acting High Commissioner in U.K., 1965-67; Secretary, Prime Minister's Secretariat, 1967-71; Principal Secretary to the Prime Minister, 1971-73; Chairman, National Institute of Public Finance and Policy, 1972-75; Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission, 1975-77; Chairman, Indian Statistical Institute, Zaheer Science Foundation, National Committee on Science and Technology, 1975-77; Vice-President Council of Science and Technology 1975-77; Co-Chairman, Indo-Soviet Joint Commission, 1975-77; and member, U.N. International Civil Service Commission, 1975-80; former Chairman, National Labour Institute; Editor, Man and Development, Director, Press Trust of India; Chairman and Director of various committees & commissions; received various national and international awards including the Soviet Land Nehru Award in 1987; died in 1998.

His published works include - 'Premonitions' 1979, 'Reflections of Our Times', 1982, 'Problems of Foreign Policy', 'One More Life (Autobiography) etc.
