Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi (1869-1948)

Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi was born at Porbandar, Gujarat on 2 October 1869; ed. Rajkot, Bhavnagar and London and qualified as Barrister, 1889; practiced law in Bombay, Kathiawar and South Africa and lived in South Africa from 1893 to 1915; involved himself in the cause of Indians abroad and returned to India, 1915; opened an Ashram at Kochrab, Ahmedabad and later shifted to Sabarmati, which was named Satyagraha Ashram, 1917; initiated and led the Champaran and Kheda Satyagraha, 1917 and 1918 and Non-Cooperation campaign, 1920; associated with Khilafat agitation, 1919-21; imprisoned and released, 1922-24; President of Indian National Congress, 1924; inaugurated campaign for Civil Disobedience, April 1930; interned, May 1930 and released on January, 1931; delegate to the Second Round Table Conference, 1931; signed the truce with Lord Irwin, March 1931; imprisoned, January 1932-33; launched Quit India Movement and imprisoned, August 1942- May 1944; visited Noakhali, 1946; under took a fast for communal harmony, January 1948; assassinated, 30 January 1948.

Some of his publications includes: *Indian Home Rule, Universal Dawn*, *Autobiography* (2 Vols.), *Self-Indulgence vs. Self-Control, Guide to health*; edited *Harjian* (English, Gujarati and Hindi), *Young India and Navajivan* (Hindi and Gujarati)
