SUBIMAL DUTT (1903-1992)

Subimal Dutt was a distinguished civil servant and renowned diplomat, Born on March 13, 1903 at Chittagong, son of late R. C. Dutt; Edu. Presidency College, Calcutta, University College, London; Joined Indian Civil Service, 1928; served as Asstt. Magistrate, Joint Magistrate and Collector, Addl. Distt. & Sessions Judge & Magistrate Collector in Bengal till 1938; Under Secretary & later Deputy Secretary to Govt. of India, Deptt. of Education, Health & Lands, 1938-41; Agent to Govt. of India, in Malaya, 1941; Served the Govt. of Bengal till 1947; Secretary to Govt. of India, Commonwealth Relations from August 1947; Secretary, External Affairs Ministry, 1950-52; served on the Punjab Boundary Commission and headed the commission on industrial licensing policy in 1968 and was later the Central Vigilance Commissioner; Ambassador to Bangladesh immediately after its independence; died, 2 March 1992.
