Born on October 8, 1921 at Dehradun, Uttarakhand; edu. D.A.V. College, Dehra Dun, Viswa Bharati, Santiniketan; Career, participated in Quit India Movement,1942, Bhoodan Movement in Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra, 1953-54, War Resisters' International World Campaign Against the American War in Vietnam, 1966-72, Operation Omega - a project in support of the fight for freedom by the people of Bangladesh, 1971; Chairman, War Resisters' International(WRI), London; Secretary General, War Resisters' International (India), Secretary, Lansbury House Trust Fund London; Member, All India Board of Hindustani Talimi Sangh, Sevagram; Executive Committee, Sarva Seva Sangh, Varanasi; Follow up Committee: An International Consultation in Search of Non-Violence Alternatives, Belgium, Council Member, Peace Brigades International USA; Board of Directors, Peace News, London, etc. Died on 1 June 2011.

His publications include *Child-Art and Education* and *Bacchon ki Kala aur Shiksha* and his contribution as an editor of *Nai Talim-* an official journal of Hindustani Talimi Sangh, *War Resistance-* Quarterly Journal of the WRI and *Gandhi Marg*(Hindi)- official journal of the Gandhi Peace foundation.
