#### **BIO-DATA**

#### **SHIVDAN SINGH CHAUHAN (1918-2000)**

One of the leading Hindi literary figures and art critics, Shivdan Singh Chauhan was born in 1918 at Agra; graduated from Allahabad University, 1937; was one of the founders of the All-India Studentsq Federation and All-India Progressive Writersq Associations Hindi Branch in 1936 and its Secretary in 1939; wrote short stories, critical essays, translations etc; imprisoned in Benaras Central Jail, 1942; opposed communal riots of 1947, organized National Cultural Front (1947-49) and National Cultural Congress, Kashmir (1949-51) as its Secretary; also became the Secretary of the Cultural Commission of All-India Peace Council and Indo-Soviet Cultural Society, 1961; participated in several National and International Literary Conferences; attended the First Afro-Asian WritersqConference at Tashkent as a member of the Indian Writers Delegation, 1958; became the Chairman of the Northern Regional Advisory Board of Nehru Award Committee after Harivansh Rai Bachchan and remained so till 1992.

Some of his important collections of critical essays are: Pragativadq (1946), Sahitya ki Parakhq(1947), Sahitya ki Samasyayeinq(1958), Alochana ka Manq (1958), etc. Some of his important books are Rakt Ranjit Spain (1938), Hindi Gadya-Sahitya (1952), Sahitya ke Assi Varsh (1954) which was translated into Russian; translated more than 30 world classics including the works of Leo Tolstoy, Chekhov, George Bernard Shaw, Maxim Gorky and others; nearly 67 dozen of his critical articles, essays and reviews have been published by almost all leading journals and magazines of Hindi; edited some Hindi Literary Journals such as Hans (1940-44), Alochana (1950-52 and 1963-66), Naya Sahitya (1946-48), etc; awarded several prizes and honors by the Central Government, Punjab and U.P. Governments for his writings: died on the 29 August 2000.

#### **VIJAY CHAUHAN (1930-2011)**

A well-known writer, poetess, critic and journalist, Vijay Chauhan was born in 1930 in Punjab in the family of Chhabil Das, a close associate of Lala Lajpat Rai; participated in Quit India Movement; wrote poems in Hindi, English and Punjabi; a regular contributor of short stories, literary and critical essays and sociological articles to journals and magazines; a regular contributor to AICC journal *Social India* and to *The Hindustan Times*; invited by the Gorky Institue of World Literature in Moscow for research in Soviet Literature in 1960; Delegate to the 25<sup>th</sup> World Orientalist Congress held in Moscow; participated in several national and international conferences of writers and intellectuals; worked as a Senior Lecturer in English at Deshbandhu College, New Delhi.

Translated more than 40 world classics including major works of Dostoevsky, Dickens, Anderson, Gorky and other titans; translated important works of eminent Punjabi writers; won several prizes for translations from Central and Punjab Government; also the winner of the Soviet Land Nehru Award of 1972 for the translation of Doestoevsky and Gorkycs works.
