Bio-data

Krishna Bharadwaj (1935 – 1992)

Krishna Bharadwaj, an economist, born on 21 August 1935 at Karwar, Western Coast of India, daughter of Maruti Chandawarkar, an educationist who supported education for women and child, widows, completed college education in Bombay (1951); Doctorate from Bombay University 1960; joined centre for International Studies at MIT; Joined as a lecturer in the Deptt. of Economics, Bombay University 1962; awarded Fellowship at Cambridge in 1967; associated with other renowned economist viz. Piero Sraffa, John Robinson, Maurice Dobb, Richard Kahn, Nicholas Kaldor, Luigi Pasinetti and with a group of young economist from England and Europe interested in the classical and Marxian theory; Senior Research Officer, Deptt. of Applied Economics Cambridge 1968-69; joined Visiting Professor at Delhi School of Economics 1971 and later at Jawaharlal Nehru University 1971-1991. Died on 8 March 1992.
