BIO-DATA

LT. GEN. S. P. P. THORAT ( 1906-1992 )

One of the most decorated officers of the Indian Army and a great soldier, Lt. Gen. Thorat, receiptent of Ashok Chakra-II, Padma Shree, D.S.O., was born on 12 August 1906 at village Vadgaon of the erstwhile princely state of Kolhapur; married Dr. Leela Anand in 1936; had primary education at his village and later studied in S.P. College, Poona, after graduating from Royal Military College, Sandhurst (U.K.) in 1924; joined the Indian Army as a King's Commissioned Officer in 1926; appointed Commander, East Punjab Area in 1948; served as Secretary on a Committee constituted for establishment of the famous National Defence Academy at Khadakvasla.

During World War-II, Major Thorat after the battle of Kohima and seige of Imphal, was promoted to the rank of Lt. Colonel, awarded Distinguished Service Order (D.S.O.) for his outstanding gallantry and leadership in the classic battle of Kangaw in Burma against the Japanese, 1945; became Chief of the General Staff in 1950; in 1953 assigned the command of the Indian Custodian Force in Korea at the request of U.N. and for his bravery in tackling the P.O.W.s; decorated with the Ashok Chakra-II and invested with order of Padma Shree; appointed G.O.C. in C. Eastern Command in 1957; retired in 1961.

After his retirement, served in the Maharashtra Public Service Commission and was instrumental in getting up the Service Selection Board which he headed for two years during 1962-63. After Chinese aggression of 1962, was made the only military member of the National Security Council, headed by Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru; contested Lok Sabha elections from Kolhapur district in 1967; died on 10 August 1992.
