Baleshwar Prasad I.A.S. (Retd.), Lt. Governor of Delhi, born in 1st January 1914 at Chapra (Saran Dist. Bihar); son of Maheshwar Prasad, married Uma; passed M.A. in 1936 from Patna; joined Journalism; 1937-39, Connected with Business Enterprises; 1939-41, connected with Indian Independence Movement in East Asia and was President of Indian Independence League; Burma; 1942-46, connected with Industrial Undertakings, 1946-50, I.A.S. Officer in Bihar; 1950-56, Political adviser to Delegation to International Commission for Supervision and Control in Vietnam; 1956-59, Dewan of Sikkim; 1959-63, Chief Commissioner of Manipur; 1963-69, its Lt. Governor; December 1969-January 1970, Ambassador of Burma; February 1970-August 1971, Lt. Governor of Tripura; August 1971-March 1972; Died in 1996.
