

Janata Party

After Emergency, five National Parties namely Congress(O), Jan Sangh, Bharatiya Lok Dal, Socialist Party and Swatantra Party merged to form Janata Party during the 6th Lok Sabha Elections. The Janata Party formed the government in centre on 24 March 1977 with Morarji Desai as Prime Minister. Due to continuous in-fightings and ideological differences the Janata government was unable to effectively address national problems. By mid 1979, Morarji Desai resigned and Chaudhary Charan Singh became Prime Minister on 28 July 1979. Former allies of Janata Party such as DMK, Shiromani Akali Dal and the Communist Party of India (Marxist) had distanced themselves from the Janata Party for which Chaudhary Charan Singh also had to resign on 14 January 1980. Between 1980 and 1989, the Janata Party maintained a small presence in the Indian Parliament under the leadership of Socialist politician Chandra Shekhar. In 1988 the Janata Party, Jan Morcha, Lok Dal(B), Congress(S) merged to form Janata Dal. Janata Dal joined hands with the rightist and leftist parties and formed National Front Government at the centre in 1989 with V.P. Singh as Prime Minister. However, V.P. Singh's Government soon fell victim to intra-party rivalries and power struggles, and his successor Chandra Shekhar's Janata Dal (Socialist) Government lasted from November 1990 - June 1991. Although the original Janata Party fragmented and dissolved, modern political parties continued to invoke its legacy. In August 2013 Janata Party was merged with the Bharatiya Janata Party.
