NEHRU MEMORIAL MUSEUM AND LIBRARY

52nd Annual Report, 2017-18

The Nehru Memorial Museum and Library established in 1966 as a Society, registered under the Registration of Societies Act of 1860 has completed 52 years of its existence during the period covered by this report. In continuing with the aims and objectives of the Society as stated in its Memorandum of Association, the institution has taken up a number of robust practices especially in regard to historical research and study of the contemporary society through a multidisciplinary concept. The 2018-19 Report encapsulates these initiatives taken up by the institution.

The Nehru Memorial Museum and Library consists of Pradhan Mantri Sangrahalaya; a Library which has a pre-eminent position among the social science libraries in the country; the Research and Publications Division; the Centre for Contemporary Studies; the Manuscripts Division; the Reprography Division; the Oral History Division; and the Planetarium.

ORGANISATION

The Executive Council of the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library met five times during the year (4 May 2017, 30 June 2017, 9 August 2017, 5 December 2017 and 20 February 2018). The Finance Committee met four times in the year (8 September 2017, 13 November 2017, 4 December 2017 and 20 February 2018) and the Annual General Body meeting of the NMML Society was held on 22 August 2017. The names of the members of the Society, its Executive Council and Finance Committee are given in the Appendix.

A resume of the activities of the Society during the period 1 April 2017 to 31 March 2018, department-wise, is as follows:

PRADHAN MANTRI SANGRAHALAYA

It has been decided to create an integrated seamless Pradhan Mantri Sangrahalaya merging the erstwhile Teen Murti Bhawan and the newly-constructed building for the Sangrahalaya. In 2016-17, the Ministry of Culture, Government of India gave shape to the idea of establishing a museum in Delhi dedicated to all the Prime Ministers of the country. The Honourable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi announced this momentous decision to honour the legacy of India's Prime Ministers and highlight their contribution to nation-building. It led to the commencement of the project. The Ministry of Culture entrusted the project to the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library (NMML).

Conceptualised as an institution of national importance its Digital and Educational Vision Statement proposes to utilise state-of-the-art digital display for narrating the history of contemporary India through its Prime Ministers; to effectively engage a wide spectrum of audiences with varied interests and curate memorable cultural experiences. The Museum is planned to be a source of

knowledge and inspiration through the history of contemporary India with the role and achievements of all its Prime Ministers since 1947 and make it a memorable visiting experience.

The new state-of-the-art digital Museum would be spread over 11,470 sq. metres. The civil work has been entrusted to CPWD. The building work has started. The internal civil finishing and electrical and mechanical works are in progress in full swing. The work on identification of Content for display and curation of displays is in progress. The work of curation of content is in progress. A sum of Rs. 1.73 crores has been spent on the project till March, 2018 against the estimated cost of Rs. 271.07 crores.

LIBRARY

The Library of the NMML has been designed and developed as a research and reference centre on Modern Indian History and Contemporary issues with its very rich and varied collection of books, journals, photographs, maps, stamps and e-resources (i.e. CD-ROMs, DVDs, Microforms, E-Journals and Online Database). Owing to its rich and rare collection on modern and contemporary history and allied subjects, the Library continues to occupy a pre-eminent position among social science libraries in India and abroad.

During the period under review, 3,239 publications were added to the Library collection. Out of these, 2,151 publications were purchased, 474 publications were bound-volumes of journals, which were transferred by the Periodical Section of the Library. One hundred and fifteen books were received as gifts from individuals and institutions, 180 books from B.R. Nanda, 19 books from Santosh Kumar, and 300 books from Natrang Pratishthan. In the acquisition of publication for the Library, due emphasis continued to be laid on acquiring books in Hindi. During the period, 1,077 Hindi books were added. The total number of books in the Library has gone up from 2,88,117 to 2,91,356.

The Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC) scheme has been adopted for the processing of the Library documents. The housekeeping operation and catalogue is computerised using LIBSYS integrated library management software. Online Public Access Catalogue search is provided to readers. Searches can be made by author, title, subject, class number, publisher or by words in title and Boolean search. The newly accessioned documents are displayed in the library on regular basis.

Journals: The collection of research materials at the Library has been growing constantly in the form of documentary and non-documentary materials. The Library has currently 384 journals, out of which, 137 are foreign journals. In terms of language, 324 journals are in English, 54 are in Hindi and the remaining six are in other Indian languages.

The Library receives 29 daily newspapers. While 20 Newspapers are in English, eight are in Hindi and one in Urdu.

Photographs: During the year, 3,408 photographs were added to the holdings of the Photo Library. Out of these, 324 photographs were under General Collection, 3,084 photographs of Dr. Manmohan Singh, (Former Prime Minister of India) which include his various activities and visits during the year 2004-2014. The number of photographs in the Library has gone up from 2,11,780 to 2,15,188.

During the period under review, 56 new albums were added to the Photo Library, taking the number from 2,918 to 2,974.

Also, 70,000 photographs have been digitised and made available to the research scholars on intranet through DSpace DMS.

E-Resources: The Library has added e-resource in the form of e-journals, microfilms, CD-ROMs/DVDs, and Online database. The Library subscribes to approximately 2,000 journals through JSTOR online archival database, which provides online access of books and journals on various subjects. In addition to this, the Library subscribes 60 online journals, available with the print edition. The web link of online journals has been put on the website of the NMML. During the period under review, 40 Microforms have been added to the research materials of the Library, which includes 2 rolls of the Papers of Dhan Gopal Mukherji, 1928-1936; 4 rolls of Report of the Marwari Association, 1914-16, 1923-30, 1932-33; 33 rolls of *The New York Times*, 1 January 1948 to 31 December 1948, and 1 roll of Sarat Chandra and Subhas Chandra Bose Collections, 1931-35 and 1942-45. The total number of Microfilm rolls has gone up from 18,439 to 18,479. The Microfiche collection stands at 51,322, the CD stands at 347, and the DVDs collection at 874.

Exhibitions: During the year the Library organised, 'Exhibition of Rare Books: 1700-1900', 11-14 May 2017; 'Exhibition of Books on Prime Ministers of India', 13-19 November 2017, and also brought out printed bibliographical information in the form of catalogue. It is being used by the research scholar as a research and reference tool.

Members of Library Network/Associations: The Library is an active member of DELNET and has been making considerable use of the network's facilities for inter-library loan, acquiring references, document delivery services and ascertaining the availability of documents. As a part of this network, the Library makes available its rich resources to other members of the network. The Library is also an institutional member of the Indian Library Association, Indian Association of Special Libraries and Information Centres.

Library Services: The Library provides a variety of services like reference, photocopy, document delivery service, Inter-library Loan, etc.

Library Consultations: During the period under review, the scholars consulted 78,200 books, 22,500 loose issues of journals and 10,090 bound-volumes of journals. Also 6,484 Microfilm rolls and 54,173 Microfiche plates were given to the scholars for consultation. Besides, 1,030 Microfilm

rolls and 820 Microfiche plates were handled for supplying photocopies of materials required by the scholars.

Scanning of 2,973 photographs was done from 516 albums, and scanned copies of the photographs were supplied to research scholars/staff in 85 CDs/ DVDs/Pen Drives. The Library also dealt with 2,924 reference queries.

Five hundred and fifty-seven (557) research scholars, representatives of government departments, institutions and mass-media agencies visited the Photo Library and availed of its services.

Library Membership: The Library continued to attract the academic community from around the world. During the year, 18,862 scholars were served by the Library, an average of 63 scholars per day. In all 1,222 scholars became members of the Library during the year. An amount of Rs.7,70,525/- was realised from them as membership fee, and Rs. 2,04,090/- for copies of photographs provided to research scholars. The total revenue of the Library was Rs. 9,75,615/-.

Reading Facilities:

- 1. *Centre for the Visually Impaired*: The Library has a small centre for Visually Impaired scholars. It is equipped with computer, scanner, printer and microfilm reader.
- 2. *Cyber Centre*: A fully equipped Computing Thin-Clint based Cyber Centre is working for the users of the NMML Library. There are eight computer terminals with printer and all other facilities. Users who do not know how to use these facilities, the Library offers personalised service to help them.
- 3. Wi-Fi Facility: The Library also provides free Wi-Fi facility for its research scholars.

RESEARCH AND PUBLICATIONS DIVISION

Rajaji Project

The Nehru Memorial Museum and Library has undertaken the publication of the *Selected Works of C. Rajagopalachari* and has already published three volumes of the same. During the period under review, the publication of the Volume IV was in process. Also the *Selected Works of C. Rajagopalachari*, Volume IV (1926-30), comprising 563pages, has been published.

The work of finalising the manuscript of the VolumeV has been accomplished. The material from newspapers on the microfilm was collected for the subsequent volumes and was sorted for the years 1940-1947. The selected documents were typed and compared. Material from C.R. Papers and other Private Papers were typed from the year 1952-1962.

In addition to this, the Research Section also provided its valuable inputs and suggestions for exhibition on the former Prime Ministers of India, Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee and Shri P.V. Narasimha Rao.

CENTRE FOR CONTEMPORARY STUDIES

The Centre for Contemporary Studies (CCS) runs a Fellowship Programme which is highly regarded in the academic world. During the year 32 Fellows were in position, and made significant progress in their respective research projects.

It also regularly conducts academic activities such as Book Release, Lectures, Conferences, Panel Discussions, Special Lecture, Conferences/Workshops, etc. These lectures, delivered by accomplished scholars, academics, and young researchers, are based on original research and they are regularly attended by university teachers, college students and people interested in the study of Modern Indian History and contemporary issues. MANUSCRIPTS SECTION

The Manuscripts Division acquires and preserves private papers of distinguished individuals and records of political and other non-official organisations, associations and societies that played a significant role in the development of modern India. These archival materials, which form the primary source of information for research, are made available to scholars.

During the period under review, the following papers were added to its archival holdings:

I. Personal Papers

1. Papers of N.M. Ghatate

Senior Advocate, Supreme Court of India

Dr. N.M. Ghatate donated his own papers, comprising approximately 130 letters of political detenues, under MISA during the Emergency, in central and district jails, such as Atal Bihari Vajpayee, L.K. Advani and others. The papers, covering the period 1975-1977, are in Hindi, English and Marathi.

II. Other Papers

The Manuscripts Division also acquired two more instalments of Prof. Deepak Kumar papers and one each of Jatindranath Mukherjee papers, R.S. Derashri papers and G.N. Devy papers.

Research and Reference

During the period under review, the total number of scholars attended to in the Reading Room was 755. These scholars were recommended by their respective Universities/Institutions in India and abroad for consulting our archival holdings. Eleven thousand nine hundred and thirteen (11,913) files from different collections were supplied to them for consultation. In addition, 94,203 pages were xeroxed for being supplied to individual scholars as well as for official use.

Digitisation of Archival Material

Archival material available in the Division is being digitised for posterity. During the period under review, the collections which have been digitised are: C. Rajagopalachari (V, VI-XII and XIII instalments), Cabinet Papers, Rahul Bajaj, H.V. Kamath, Janata Party (I and II instalments), Jayaprakash Narayan (III instalments), Prof. Deepak Kumar and Syama Prasad Mookerjee (I instalment). Before digitisation, all the files and documents were checked with their catalogues and arranged chronologically; correspondence files were arranged alphabetically, stamped and paginated. The collections which were scanned during the period consist of approximately 3,76,037 pages. Also the metadata of approximately 3,75,000 pages was prepared.

REPROGRAPHY DIVISION

During the period under review, the work of Microfilming of Newspapers made substantial progress. In all, the Division prepared approximately 51,852 frames on 35mm Negative Microfilm of the newspapers such as *The Telegraph*, *Deccan Chronicle* and *Dharmayug*, etc. The Microfilm Rolls generated during the period under review have been accessioned after proper checking, editing and indexing.

The rewashing of the old Microfilm Negatives is under progress. During the period, the Division prepared 2,034 negative rolls including those of *Amrita Bazar Patrika*, *Asian Age*, *Vandematram*, and *Bombay Chronicle* and also rewinding of 2,034 old master rolls. Seventy one (71) Direct Duplicate and 97 Duplicate Microfilms were prepared and supplied to the Library for consultation of the scholars.

Approx. 10,327 Microfilm Scanned images in CD/DVDs for individual scholars, various institutions and also for the use of different sections of the organisation were prepared. Approximately 57,220 Photostat copies were generated for supply to various divisions of our organisation, and 203 scholars were attended to meet their demands for various types of Reprographic services.

The Division also covered various seminars and official functions held in office and exposed around 24,251 photographs, prepared 81 Exhibition posters, 55 Seminars and Conference poster, and covered 100 different official functions.

Preservation unit:

During the period under review, 2,268 sheets were given lamination treatment, 6,926 documents were given full pasting, 3,043 sheets of archival documents were treated with tissue pasting, 1,564 books/files were given for fumigation treatment, and 4,796 sheets of manuscripts, files/documents were guarded. The Unit prepared 43 Albums of Polyester envelops with removal of 3,729 photographs from old albums, stitched 96 parcel of CD/DVD and documents. Besides, binding of 25 books of the Library with rexin, transcripts, and 425 documents of the Manuscripts Division, guard removal of 150 documents, cutting of 8,700 documents and slips checking of 33,936 archival papers, washing patch removal of 6,462 manuscript papers, and flattening of 102 papers of documents, etc. were also carried out.

Digitisation: Digitisation and Microfilming of the NMML artefacts by M/s SG Informatics Pvt. Ltd. under the supervision of Reprography was in progress and approximately 4,67,976 pages of manuscripts were digitised. It also Microfilmed 300 rolls from digitised data. One thousand three hundred and eight (1,308) hrs of recording on spool tapes has been converted into digital format, and approximately 5,52,354 digitised documents have also been uploaded on open source digital Library software 'D-Space' deployed for retrieval of digital material.

ORAL HISTORY DIVISION

The Oral History Division generates documents relating to the social and political development of modern India through interviews with distinguished individuals who have played a prominent role in public affairs. During the period under review, one new person, i.e. Dr. N.M. Ghatate (1937-), a close associate of former Prime Minister, Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee, was interviewed over six sessions. This brings the total number of persons and sessions recorded so far to 1,366 and 5,584 respectively. The transcripts of 15 interviews were finalised, which comprised of 841 pages, bringing the total number of finalised transcripts to 952.

A brief account of the interviews finalised during the year is given below:

1. Bhabani Prasad Bannarji (1922-)

Freedom Fighter from West Bengal.

His recording include, among other things, Quit India Movement, Revolutionary Socialist Party and Lal Bahadur Shastri.

2. SHEILA BHATIA (1916-2008)

Legend of Indian Opera from Sialkot (now in Pakistan)

She mainly recorded songs written and sung by her.

3. VED PRAKASH BHATIA (1923-)

Indian National Army Personnel from Punjab

He mainly spoke on Indian National Army's personnel, formation of INA and Subhas Chandra Bose.

4. KAUSHALYA DEVI (1914-)

Freedom Fighter and sister of Satyavati Devi from Punjab

She has mainly recorded her paternal grandfather Swami Shraddhanand, sister Satyavati Devi, and political activities in Delhi since 1920.

5. VEETIKA VENKITESWARAN (1924-)

Journalist from Kerala

He recorded his reminiscences with regard to his association with *The Statesman* and *The Hindustan Times*.

6. JUSTICE RAM NARAINGURTU (1901-97)

Former Judge of Allahabad High Court from Uttar Pradesh

He spokemainly on the members of the Nehru family.

7. KAPOOR CHAND JAIN (1907-91)

Freedom Fighter from Delhi

His transcript is mainly on Delhi (Special) Congress (1923) and communalism.

8. S.C. JAMIR (1931-)

Former Chief Minister of Nagaland and Governor of Odisha from Nagaland

He spoke on the Naga insurgency and experiences in Lok Sabha.

9. GAURI 'RUBI' JOSHI (1935-2012)

Sister of Kalpana Dutt, and member IPTA, Bombay, from Chittagong (now in Bangladesh) She spoke on Kalpana Dutt.

10. NATESA KRISHNASWAMY (1924-2003)

Freedom Fighter, former Secretary to J.B. Kripalani, Sarvodayaist and associated with Gandhi Peace Foundation, from Tamil Nadu

His transcript is on S. Satyamurti and C. Rajagopalachari.

11. TARA DEVI SAXENA (1923-)

Freedom Fighter and Congressperson from Uttar Pradesh

She recorded Agra Mahila Congress of the 1940s and Delhi since 1956.

12. GAUTAM SEN (1951-)

Former Additional Controller General of Defence Accounts from IDAS (Indian Defence Accounts Service), Government of India from West Bengal

He has mainly recorded Sri Lanka and north-east India.

13. Dr. Shanti Swaroop Sharma (1914-2000)

Freedom Fighter, former Commissioner, Thanesar, and Journalist from Saharanpur (UP)

He has mainly spoken on Mahatma Gandhi's fast (1932) and Kurukshetra Refugee Camp (1947).

14. COMRADE PARDUMAN SINGH (1924-2007)

Communist, Trade Unionist and Father of Pension Scheme for Non-Government and Non-Organized Sector, from Punjab

He has recorded social security and pension scheme for old age people.

15. HARKISHAN SINGH SURJEET (1916-2008)

Freedom Fighter and Leader CPI (M) from Punjab

He has recorded his role in the freedom movement.

The division also sent out the transcript of Gopal Krishna Pillai (1949-), former civil servant, and the first installment of the transcript of Prof. Deepak Nayyar (1946-), former Vice-Chancellor, University of Delhi, for vetting and approval.

NEHRU PLANETARIUM

During the period under review, 2,25,370 visitors purchased the Sky Theatre tickets and viewed the Planetarium shows. Of these, 85,482 were school children visiting in special groups, seeing the Planetarium shows at highly concessional rates.

A brief account of activities conducted by the Planetarium during the year is as follows:

Publication and Paper presentation

- Director, Nehru Planetarium, gave a talk on the Jantar Mantar observatories titled 'Bharatiya Vigyan Sammelan 2017,' with a focal theme of 'Confluence of Traditional and Modern Sciences: A New Integral Vision for Development' at a meeting held at Pune, 12-14 May 2017.
- Director, Planetarium, gave a Lecture, titled 'Jantar Mantar Observatories of India: Usage as Teaching Laboratories for Basic Astronomy:' at SEHER 2018: Taking Science beyond the Classroom, organised by Lady Shri Ram College, University of Delhi, 1 February 2018.
- Two research publications (1) 'Towards the Restoration of the Jantar Mantar Observatory Instruments at Delhi: Calibration and Observations with the Jaiprakas and Ram Yantra', with

three Planetarium staff members as co-authors, and (2) 'A Quantitative Study of Accuracies in Positions of Star Markers on Historical Astrolabes', with one Planetarium staff member as a co-author, have appeared in the proceedings of the IX International Conference on Oriental Astronomy.

Seminars/Public Lectures

- The Planetarium organised a Talk 'Life in the Universe' by Prof. Mayank Vahia, Tata Institute of Fundamental Research (TIFR), Mumbai, followed by an interactive discussion session on Astronomy Olympiads and careers in Astronomy, 6 April 2017.
- The Planetarium organised a Talk in its Sky Theater titled'Gravity Defied: From Potato Asteroids to Magnetized Neutron Stars' by Dr. Sushan Konar, National Center for Radio Astrophysics, Pune, 21 April 2017.
- The Planetarium, in collaboration with SPACE, organised Asteroid Day activities, 30 June 2017. Positions in the sky of student discoveries of asteroids have been added to the Planetarium system software and shown in the Planetarium Sky Theatre to the participants during an interactive Sky Theater session on asteroids. Student discoverers of asteroids were present as panel members for interaction with the participants.
- Public lecture 'Towards the Restoration of Jantar Mantar Observatory, Delhi: Calibrations and Observations with Jaiprakash Yantra', at the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library, 27 July 2017.

Exhibitions

• Installation and inauguration of an 'ASTROSAT Corner' at the Planetarium, containing the prototype Soft X-Ray telescope optics, donated by the TIFR, a large sized model of the Astrosat spacecraft built by the Planetarium, posters touch screen and running outreach video content on the spacecraft and the payloads, 11 November 2017.

Astronomy Workshops

- The Planetarium conducted a Celestial Navigation Workshop for Air Force personnel on a request from Garud Regimental Training Centre, Hindon, in the Sky Theater, 11 May 2017.
- The Planetarium, in collaboration with the RAD@home collaborative, conducted a week-long Radio Astronomy Workshop for B.Sc./B.Tech. students as a part of the summer activities, July 2017. Dr. Ananda Hota, from the Center for Excellence in Basic Sciences, Mumbai, is the founder of this initiative and he gave a week long guidance to the participants in the Workshop, through skype interaction.

Telescope Skywatch

- The Planetarium conducted regular monthly Sky Watch with telescopes in the Teen Murti campus, and four telescope Sky Watch activities off campus at various schools in the NCR region, during the year.
- Lunar Eclipse Observation 31 January 2018 evening, was conducted with telescopes for General Public from the lawns of the Teen Murti House. Around 3,000 people witnessed this celestial event.

Educational Programmes

- The Planetarium organised a programme celebrating the National Science Day on 28 February 2018, with activities under 'Celestial and Terrestrial Science in our daily lives'.
- Team Indus leaders organised a programme on 10 August 2017 at the Planetarium. There was a special interactive exhibits as well as a travelling Moon Shot bus with exhibits. A live presentation on the Moon, prepared by the Planetarium, was organised in the Sky Theater of the Planetarium and followed by interaction with Team Indus leaders.
- The Planetarium organised its Annual Space Art Contest in February 2017 and the Annual Astronomy Quiz Contest for Government and Public school students, 28 August 2017.
- The Planetarium, in collaboration with an NGO the Standing Together to Enable Peace (STEP), organised a programme called 'Reclaiming Childhood' for under privileged children, 1 October 2017.
- The Planetarium organised a Solar Observations Festival on 20 December 2017.
- The Planetarium conducted 'Moon Carnival' for invited school students of classes 3-7, 3 January 2018.
- The Planetarium organised a programme 'Shikshakon se Baatcheet', titled 'Sun, Moon, Stars, Seasons and Sky Relevance in Elementary Curriculum' conducted by the Director, Nehru Planetarium, 16 March 2018.
- During the summer, week long Puppetry and Theater Workshops with celestial themes were conducted, and at the end, the children presented their own productions in the campus.
- The Planetarium mentored the participation of under-graduate and post-graduate students from Delhi and NCR regions in the Delhi chapter of the Skywatchers' Association Network (SWAN), a Radio Astronomy initiative of the Raman Research Institute.
- The Planetarium, in collaboration with the Archeological Survey of India and the Astronomical Society of India, conducted a 'Festival of Measurement' at the Jantar Mantar observatory, on the terrace of the Manmandir, Varanasi, 15 April 2017.

Commemorations

• The Nehru Planetarium organised a commemoration programme 'Remembering Prof. Yashpal and Prof. U. R. Rao' with an exhibition and seminar, 7 September 2017. Exhibition was prepared in-house. The Seminar was chaired by Shri Biman Basu and the speakers were Prof. Shyam Tandon and Prof. Ajit Kembhavi from Inter University Center for Astronomy and Astrophysics, Pune, Dr. B. S. Guruprasad from ISRO, and Shri Pramod Galgali, Director, Jawaharlal Nehru Planetarium, Bangalore.

HINDI UNIT

Progressive use of Hindi

The work relating to the implementation of the Official Language Policy in the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library is being looked after by the Hindi Unit. The Departmental Official Language Implementation Committee of the Organisation is constituted under the Chairmanship of the Director, NMML.

During the period under review, the Hindi Unit organised Seven Hindi Workshops on 'Soochna Praudyogikee evam Hindi', 'Hindi mein Sarkari Karya', 'Unicode aur Sarkari Karya', 'Hindi ke Vividh Aayam', 'Rajbhasha Hindi aur Manovigyaan', 'Hindi ka Itihas' and 'Hindi mein Tippan evam Aalekhan'. Also four meetings of the Official Language Implementation Committee were held on 23 June 2017, 15 September 2017, 19 December 2017, and 20 March 2018.

In compliance with the directions of the Department of Official Language, 'Hindi Pakhwada' was organised from 14 to 28 September 2017 in the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library. Famous Author and Litterateur, Dr. Narendra Kohli inaugurated it. During this period, various competitions like Essay writing, Noting/Drafting, Film Show, Quiz, Translation, Story Writing, Speeches, and Planetarium Walk (Nehru Planetarium) were organised for the employees of the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library with the aim to promote and encourage the use of Hindi in day-to-day official work of the institution. On 10 October 2017, a prize distribution function of 'Hindi Pakhwada' was held in the Auditorium and the Director, NMML, gave away 67 prizes to the winners.

Accounting Policies and Notes to Accounts for the Financial Year Ended 31.03.2018

The Nehru Memorial Museum and Library (NMML) was established on 01.04.1966 under the Societies Registration Act, 1860. The NMML is primarily a research institution and is engaged in the research work of high order in Social Sciences – particularly Modern Indian History and to establish, maintain and run Museum and library. It is a non-profit earning, non-manufacturing body and is fully funded by the Ministry of Culture, Government of India. The Accounts of the entity comprise of the accounts of the NMML Society, Modernization Project Fund and General Provident Fund and Contributory Provident Fund of the Society.

A. Accounting Policies

1. Accounting Convention

The financial statements of the NMML have been drawn up on historical cost convention and have been prepared in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards issued by The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India on accrual basis unless otherwise stated.

2. Use of Estimates

The preparation of Financial Statements requires some estimates which effect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities on the date of Financial Statements and reported amount of Revenue and Expenses during the year. Difference between the actual result and estimates are recognized in the period in which results are known/materialized.

3. Revenue Recognition

- a. Income from sales of tickets and services are accounted for on receipt basis and is net of rebate and discount wherever applicable.
- b. Fee received for Library Membership are accounted for on accrual basis;
- Income from royalty is accounted for on cash basis and based on the terms or relevant agreement and the statement received from the publishers;
- d. Income from investments -

- (i) Interest on interest bearing securities and fixed deposits is recognized on a time proportion basis taking into account the amount outstanding and rate applicable.
- (ii) Interest pertaining to specific/ endowment fund is credited to the respective fund account.

4. Grants-in-aid

Government Grants for revenue are recognized as income to the extent amount has been utilized as expenditure in the Income and Expenditure account. Unutilized amount of grants in aid at the year end is treated as liability and carried to next year.

Government Grants for acquisition of specific fixed assets are credited to Capital fund. Further the amount equivalent to depreciation for the year is transferred to Income & Expenditure account.

5. Fund

- i) The word 'Fund' has been used to denote the intention to keep the balances invested ultimately.
- ii) Corpus refers to funds contributed by the founders with a specific direction that they form part of the corpus of the NMML and is increased/ decreased by the net operating results shown in Income and Expenditure Account (other than surplus, if any transferred to any Reserves or Earmarked Funds).
- iii) Capital Fund represents the value of fixed assets created out of the grants-in-aid.

6. Fixed Assets

Fixed Assets are stated at cost of acquisition less depreciation there on except for non-depreciable assets.

7. Depreciation

Depreciation on Fixed Assets is provided on Written down Value Method at the rates prescribed under the Income Tax Act, 1961.

8. Investments

Investments are intended to be held till the maturity as per the management policies and are valued at cost.

9. Inventories

Inventories of publications, raw microfilms are shown at cost.

10. Consumable purchased during the year are charged to expenditure during the same year.

11. Employees Benefits

Retirement benefits are comprised of General Provident Fund, Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity (DCRG), Pension and Leave Encashment as well as post-Retirement Medical benefits and are paid/ accounted for on cash basis in accordance with the Central Government Rule.

12. Contingent liabilities

Liabilities, though contingent, are provided for if there are reasonable prospects of such liabilities maturing. Other contingent liabilities, barring frivolous claims, not acknowledged as debts, are disclosed by way of note.

B. NOTES TO ACCOUNTS

1) There has been shortfall of investment of GPF Fund and CP fund as on 31.3.2018 by Rs.1,01,42,598/- (Rs.1,21,24,683/- as on 31.3.2017) as compared with the accumulated balance of GP fund and CP fund on that date. The shortfall is mainly on account of minimum interest payable as per the notification of the Central Government on the members' accumulated balance of fund and the interest earned on the investment held in earlier years.

2) Corpus Fund

During the Financial Year 2013-14 Ministry of Culture, Government of India, New Delhi vide letter No.F-9-1/2013-C&M dated 17th September 2013 has sanctioned and released a Financial Assistance of Rs.150 Crore (Rupees One hundred and fifty crore only) as one time Corpus grant to the NMML, for carryingout its activities. Further as stipulated in Para 2 of the above sanction letter, the release of the corpus fund is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- i) NMML will meet all its Annual Plan Grant requirements (including grants for creation of Capital Assets) from interest earned on this corpus amount with effect from 2014-15 onwards.
- ii) The corpus fund would be invested as per the Government of India guidelines and NMML would set up an Investment Committee. The

- interest earned will be utilized for meeting all Plan expenditure of NMML including the existing and emerging strategic objectives.
- iii) A separate account will be maintained for the interest accrued on the corpus & shall be utilized for the purpose for which it is sanctioned, and no expenditure should be incurred on the routine administrative activities.
- iv) The funds should not be diverted for any other purpose without the approval of Ministry of Culture.
- v) A Committee will be constituted by NMML to monitor the progress of the work and a report of the Committee should be submitted to the Ministry of Culture from time to time.
- vi) The assets created out of this interest should not, without the prior approval of the Government of India, be disposed or encumbered or utilized for purpose other than those for which the grant is sanctioned.
- vii) A separate register of assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the interest earned should be maintained in the prescribed form and a certified copy from the Register in respect of the assets so acquired should be sent to this Ministry annually.
- 3) Chairman of the Executive Council approved the constitution of the investment committee on 15th May. 2013. The Investment Committee consists of Dr. Vijay Kelkar as Chairman and Dr. Usha Throat, Financial Adviser, Ministry of Culture, Joint Secretary in-charge of NMML, Ministry of Culture and Director, NMML as members. This committee met three times on 14th August 2013, 5thOctober 2013 and 18thMarch 2014 and in the last meeting decided to invest the corpus fund in three nationalized banks.
- 4) As per the decision of the Executive Committee held on 24-6-2014 on the argumentation of Corpus Fund, the amount as stated below has been transferred from unutilized interest on Corpus Fund to interest apportioned to Corpus Fund as on 31-3-2018:
- -For the Financial Year 2013-2014(being 25% approx.) Rs. 1,30,00,000
- -For the Financial Year 2014-2015 (being 50% approx.) Rs.5,40,00,000

- -For the Financial Year 2015-2016 (being 50% approx.) Rs. 7,50,00,000
- -For the Financial Year 2016-2017 (being 50% approx.) Rs. 5,43,09,395.
- -For the Financial Year 2017-18 (being 50% approx.) Rs. 5,31,26,873.00
- 5) Jawaharlal Nehru Memorial Fund (JNMF) vide letter dated 29thJune 2016 has stated that it is difficult to maintain the Gratuity Fund Account of 10 persons of Nehru Planetarium unit of NMML with JNMF employees Group Gratuity Fund. JNMF vide letter dated 29thJune 2016has remitted a sum of Rs.27,07,188 being Gratuity claim up to 31.03.2016 in respect of the above employees which has been received by them from LIC in full settlement of JNMF portion covered under the LIC Policy. The amount of Gratuity claims so received has been shown under the head "Current Liabilities and Provision"- in Schedule 5. The management is in the process of making earmarked investment for this purpose.
- 6) Previous year figures have been re grouped/ recast wherever necessary. Schedules 1 to 21 form an integral part of Financial Statement.
- 7) As the year-end figures are taken from the source and rounded to the nearest digits.

Separate Audit Report of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India on the accounts of the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library, New Delhi for the year ended 31 March 2018

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of the Nehru Memorial Museum & Library (NMML), New Delhi as at 31 March 2018, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account for the year ended on that date, under Section 20 (1) of the Comptroller & Auditor General's (Duties, Powers & Conditions of Service) Act, 1971. The audit has been entrusted for the period up to 2018-19. These financial statements are the responsibility of the NMML's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

- 2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification. conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms. etc. Audit observations on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the Law. Rules and Regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects, etc., if any, are reported through Inspection Reports/ CAG's Audit Reports separately.
- 3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.
- 4. Based on our audit, we report that:
- (i) We have obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit;
- (ii) The Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure/Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the Uniform Format of Accounts approved by the Ministry of Finance.

- (iii) In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by NMML in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.
- (iv) We further report that:

A. Balance Sheet

A.1 Liabilities

A.1.1 Current Liabilities and Provisions (Schedule-5): Rs. 27.31 crore

A.1.1.1 The expenditure towards payment of 'Retirement Benefits' and 'Pension to pensioner' amounting to Rs. 96.24 lakh and Rs. 376.12 lakh respectively was made during 2017-18. As per the Significant Accounting Policy No. 11 of NMML, the retirement benefits were accounted for on cash basis. AS-15 of ICAI indicates that employees benefits obligations are to be calculated on actuarial valuation method. However, no provisions for retirement benefits on the basis of actuarial valuation were made by NMML. This was also reported in the previous year's report, but corrective action was not taken by NMML.

A.1.2 Earmarked Fund (Schedule-4): Rs. 0.47 crore

A.1.2.1 In the year 2002, an amount of Rs. 170.98 lakh was received by the NMML from Ford Foundation for 'Endowment fund and renovating & upgrading the Museum'. After accumulation of interest over the years, an amount of Rs. 255.74 lakh represented outstanding liabilities which was not accounted for in the annual accounts of NMML although it was appended with the annual accounts of NMML for the year 2017-18. This resulted in understatement of Earmarked/Endowment Funds as well as Assets by Rs. 255.74 lakh. The receipt of the fund was not disclosed during the period 2002-2003 to 2016-2017.

As mandated under FCRA Rules 1976 (Rule 4) as well as FCRA Rules 2011 (Rule 17), annual returns were to be submitted irrespective of receipt of foreign contribution. NMML furnished the annual returns to Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) only upto 2005-06. No annual return was submitted to MHA after 2005-06 in breach of FCRA Rules 1976. After implementation of FCRA Act 2010, the FCRA registration of NMML was deemed to have been cancelled from the year 2015 in terms of FCRA Act 2010. A show cause notice was received by NMML for non-submission of annual returns from MHA in July 2017, consequently, NMML applied for fresh registration in January

2018 which was yet to be granted as of May 2019. These facts were not brought out in the Notes on Accounts by NMML.

A.2 Assets

A.2.1 Current Assets Loans and Advances etc. (Schedule -9): Rs. 15.08 crore

A.2.1.1 Accrued interest amounting to Rs. 6.73 crore was depicted as 'Investments' instead of Current Assets which resulted in understatement of 'Current Assets' and overstatement of 'Investments' (fixed deposits) by the like amount.

B. Grants in Aid

- B.1 NMML received Rs. 2594.16 lakh from Ministry of Culture during the year 2017-18. It had unspent grants of Rs. 17.57 lakh from the previous year. Besides, it had internal receipts of Rs. 134.30 lakh during 2017-18. Out of the total funds, it utilized Rs. 2426.37 lakh leaving an unspent balance of Rs. 319.66 lakh.
- B.2 In addition, NMML had an unspent balance of Rs. 1.95 lakh relating to grants for Tatya Tope 200th Birth Anniversary at the beginning of the year. Out of these, Rs 0.07 lakh was adjusted as prior period adjustment (year 2016-17) making an unspent balance of Rs. 2.02 lakh under Tatya Tope 200th Birth Anniversary which was refunded to the Ministry of Culture during the year 2017-18, leaving Nil unspent balance.
- B.3 NMML had an unspent balance of Rs. 1440.70 lakh at the beginning of the year relating to non-recurring grant received from Ministry of Culture for portal, selected works and up gradation of NMML, it earned interest of Rs 290.42 lakh. It utilized Rs. 725.15 lakh during the year 2017-18 leaving an unspent balance of Rs. 1005.97 lakh as of 31 March 2018.
- B.4 NMML also received special grant of Rs. 35.00 lakh from Ministry of Culture during 2012-13 for undertaking activities for commemoration of 150th birth anniversary of Sh. Motilal Nehru. Out of this, NMML could utilize Rs. 6.95 lakh (Rs. 0.24 lakh in 2012-13 and Rs. 6.71 lakh in 2013-14) leaving an unspent balance of Rs. 28.05 lakh as on 31.3.2018.
- B.5 NMML received an amount of Rs. 150.00 crore in September 2013 as one time corpus grant from Ministry of Culture to meet its annual plan grant requirements (including grants for creation of capital assets) from the interest earned on this corpus from 2014-15 onwards. In the beginning of the year 2017-18, there was balance of Rs. 189.09 crore (Rs. 150.00 crore + 19.63 crore interest apportioned to corpus fund +

19.46 crore as accumulated excess of interest on corpus fund as per Income as Income and Expenditure Account). During 2017-18, it earned an interest of Rs. 10.62 crore leaving closing balance of Rs. 199.71 crore.

C. Management Letter: Deficiencies which have not been included in the Audit Report have been brought to the notice of the NMML through a management letter issued separately for remedial/corrective action.

(v) Subject to our observations in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.

(vi) In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the said financial statements read together with the Accounting Policies and Notes on Accounts and subject to the significant matters stated above and other matters mentioned in Annexure to this Audit Report give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India;

a. In so far as it relates to the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Nehru Memorial Museum & Library as at 31 March 2018; and

b. In so far as it relates to Income and Expenditure Account of the surplus for the year ended on that date.

Annexure

1. Adequacy of Internal Audit System

There was no internal audit system. Only a performance evaluation of NMML was conducted by the Ministry of Culture in January/February 2017 for the period covering from 2009-10 to February 2017.

2: Adequacy of Internal Control System

Internal Control System of the organization needs to be strengthened in view of the following:

- NMML did not utilize the special purpose funds released by the Ministry for undertaking activities for commemoration of 150th birth anniversary of Sh. Motilal Nehru.
- Investments of funds were not made as per the prescribed pattern fixed by the government of India.
- The response of the management to statutory audit objections was not effective as 39 audit paras relating to the period 2009-10 to 2014-17 were outstanding.
- Huge balances were kept in current account and failure to deposit the amount lying in current account in FDRs/short term deposits, led to substantial loss of interest.
- Instances were noticed where inadmissible payment of LTC was made to the employees who travelled in private ships.
- Assets register, Consumable Register and Accession register of Library were not maintained in the format prescribed as per GFR 2017.

3. System of physical verification of fixed assets

Physical verification of fixed assets had been conducted only upto 2017-18.

4. System of physical verification of inventory

The physical verification of inventory like stationary and other consumable items had been conducted up to 2017-18.

5. Regularity in payment of statutory dues

No payments over six months in respect of statutory dues were outstanding as on 31.03.2018.
