# Nehru Memorial Museum and Library

# 55<sup>th</sup> Annual Report, 2020-21

The Nehru Memorial Museum and Library, which was established in 1966 as a Society, registered under the Registration of Societies Act of 1860, has completed 55 years of its existence during the period covered by this report. While pursuing the aims and objectives of the Society set out in its Memorandum of Association, the institution has striven to improve its profile by launching a number of new initiatives in past couple of years. This report elucidates its manifold activities, especially its contribution to the realm of historical research and contemporary studies.

The Nehru Memorial Museum and Library consists of Pradhan Mantri Sangrahalaya; a Library which has a pre-eminent position among the social science libraries in the country; the Oral History Division; the Manuscripts Division; the Research and Publications Division; the Reprography Division; the Centre for Contemporary Studies; and the Planetarium.

### ORGANIZATION

The Executive Council of the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library Society met nine times during the year (4<sup>th</sup> June, 2020; 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2020; 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> September, 2020; 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2020; 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2020; 14<sup>th</sup> January, 2021; 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2021 and 6<sup>th</sup> March, 2021). The Finance Committee met three times in the year (15<sup>th</sup> May, 2020; 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 through circulation and 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2021). The names of the members of the Society, its Executive Council and Finance Committee are given in the Appendix.

A resume of the activities of the Society during the period, 1st April 2020 to 31st March 2021, department-wise, is as follows:

## PRADHAN MANTRI SANGRAHALAYA

It has been decided to create an integrated seamless Pradhan Mantri Sangrahalaya merging the erstwhile Teen Murti Bhawan and the newly-constructed building for the Sangrahalaya.

In 2016-17, the Ministry of Culture, Government of India gave shape to the idea of establishing a museum in Delhi dedicated to all the Prime Ministers of the country. The Honourable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi announced this momentous decision to honour the legacy of India's Prime Ministers and highlight their contribution to nation-building. It led to the commencement of the project. The Ministry of Culture entrusted the project to the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library (NMML).

Conceptualised as an institution of national importance its Digital and Educational Vision Statement proposes to utilise state-of-the-art digital display for narrating the history of contemporary India through its Prime Ministers; to effectively engage a wide spectrum of audiences with varied interests and curate memorable cultural experiences. The Museum is planned to be a source of knowledge and inspiration through the history of contemporary India with the role and achievements of all its Prime Ministers since 1947 and make it a memorable visiting experience.

On 15 October 2018, *Bhoomi Pujan* was performed for the Museum by Union Minister for Culture Dr. Mahesh Sharma and the Hon'ble Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs Shri Hardeep Singh Puri at Teen Murti Estate. The new state-of-the-art digital Museum would be spread over 11,470 sq. metres. The civil work has been entrusted to CPWD. The building work is nearing completion. The internal civil finishing and electrical and mechanical works are in progress in full swing. The work on identification of Content for display and curation of displays is at an advanced stage of completion. The work of curation of content is in progress. A sum of Rs. 108.09 crores has been spent on the project till March, 2021 against the estimated cost of Rs. 271.07 crores.

### LIBRARY

The NMML Library has been designed and developed as a specific research and reference centre on colonial and post-colonial India with its very rich and varied collection of books, journals, photographs, maps, stamps and E-Resources (i.e. CD-ROMs, DVDs, Microforms, E-Journals and Online Database). Due to its rich and rare collection on modern and contemporary history and allied subjects, the Library continues to occupy a pre-eminent position among social science libraries in India and abroad.

There has been a steady growth of research materials at the library in the form of documentary and non-documentary resources. The library has received 384 journals (256 subscribed and 128 received on complementary basis), out of which 144 are foreign published. 317 journals are in English, 61 are in Hindi and the remaining 6 in other Indian languages. The library subscribes 34 daily newspapers - twenty-three in English, eight in Hindi, one each in Tamil, Malayalam, and Urdu. There are 1 digital newspaper namely *Asian Wall Street Journal*.

During the period under review 2,453 resource materials were added to the Library collections. Out of these, 1104 books were purchased, 408 publications were bound-volumes of journals, which were transferred by the Periodical Section of the library. A total of 104 books came from private collection-individuals as well as institutions-700 is from Natarang Pratishthan, 30 books from Shiv Pujan Sahay Collection and 107 books from IH (India House) Collection. Due emphasis continued to be laid on acquiring books in Hindi. During the period, three hundred seven (307) Hindi books were added.

The total number of books in the Library has gone up from 2, 99,150 to 3,01,603.

The Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC) scheme has been adopted for the processing of library documents. The housekeeping operation and catalogue is computerised using Koha open

source integrated library management software. Online Public Access Catalogue search is provided to readers. Searches can be made by author, title, subject, class number, publisher or by words (in title) and Boolean search.

The newly accessioned documents are displayed regularly for the benefit of researchers.

**Photographs:** During the year 2,297 photographs were added to the Photo Library taking the total number of photographs in the library to 2,21,883 from 2,19,586. During the same period, no new albums were added to the photo library, so the number of albums is 3,014.

**E-Resources:** The library has added e-resource in the form of e-journals, microfilms, CD-ROMs/ DVDs, Online Database. It subscribes to 2,000 (approx.) journals through JSTOR online archival database that provides online access to books and journals. In addition to this the library subscribes to 106 online journals. The web link of online journals is available on the NMML website.

Indiastat, the most comprehensive compilation of secondary level socioeconomic statistical information about India that is available online, has been subscribed by the library.

**Microforms:** During the period under review, no new Microforms has been added to the research materials of the Library: so, the total of Microfilm rolls is 18,572. The Microfiche collection stands at 51,322, 383 CDs and 881 DVDs.

**Members of Library Network/Associations:** The library is an active member of DELNET, the resource sharing library network, and has been making considerable use of the network's facilities for inter-library loan, acquiring references, document delivery services and also for ascertaining the availability of documents. Through this network, the library makes available its vast collection to other participating networks. The library is also a member of the Indian Library Association, Central Government Library Association, Delhi Library Association and the Indian Association of Special Libraries and Information Centres.

**Library Services:** A range of services such as reference, photocopy, Selective Dissemination of Information (SDI), current awareness service, document delivery service, Inter-Library Loan etc are provided to scholars.

**Library Consultations:** During this period, scholars consulted 5,388 books, 653 issues of journals and 980 bound volumes of journals. Also, were consulted 2,723 microfilm rolls and 827 microfiche plates. Besides, photocopies of 749 microfilm rolls and 90 microfiche plates were made for the benefit of users.

A total of 6,992 photographs were supplied from approximately 700 albums; these scanned images were copied on various devices like CDs, DVDs, pen drives etc. and made available to scholars. In addition, the library receives queries from researchers regarding reference material. 5,523

such reference queries were addressed offline/online during this period. These include direct queries regarding availability of books, queries on format of resources, queries on references and catalogues, and blind queries on publications where there was absence of any keyword or search terms.

A total of 119 research scholars, representatives of government departments, institutions and mass-media agencies visited the Photo Library and availed of its services.

**Library Membership:** The Library continued to attract the academic community; during the period under review, 2,694 scholars accessed library resources, an average of 10 scholars per day. In all 171 new members were added during this period. The total membership fee thus collected amounted to Rs.3,23,700/- and Rs. 12,000/- for copies of photographs provided to research scholars. The total revenue of the Library was Rs.3,35,700/-.

# **Reading Facilities:**

- 1. *Centre for Visually Impaired:* The user-friendly Centre for the Visually Impaired within the library is equipped with computers, scanner, printer and microfilm reader.
- 2. *Cyber Centre:* A fully equipped Computing Thin Client (single counter serving multiple clients) based Cyber Centre is working for the library users. There are eight computer terminals with printers and all associated facilities. For those users who may find it difficult to negotiate these, the library staff is always at hand to offer help.
- 3. *Wi-Fi Facility:* Library is also providing free Wi-Fi facility for its research scholars.

# **RESEARCH AND PUBLICATIONS DIVISION**

## **RESEARCH SECTION**

The Division undertakes various projects to publish the speeches and writings of prominent national leaders in the form of *Selected Works*. At present, work on the *Selected Works of C*. *Rajagopalachari*, *Selected Works of Atal Bihari Vajpayee* and *Selected Works of Syama Prasad Mookerjee* are being carried out by the section.

## **RAJAJI PROJECT**

The Selected Works of C. Rajagopalachari Volume VI comprising 547 pages has been published. The VII Volume of the Selected Works of C. Rajagopalachari has been submitted to the publisher.

## SELECTED WORKS OF ATAL BIHARI VAJPAYEE

The Division finalised the manuscript of I&II Volumes of the Selected Works of Atal Bihari Vajpayee.

## SELECTED WORKS OF SYAMA PRASAD MOOKERJEE

The Division completed drafts of six volumes of the Selected Works of Syama Prasad Mookerjee.

#### **MUSEUM ON PRIME MINISTERS OF INDIA**

## **ORAL HISTORY DIVISION**

This division records interviews of people who have distinguished themselves in any field or came into contact with great leaders or were connected with significant movements and events either as participants or as witnesses. Transcripts of these sessions are important documents in the study of modern Indian history.

During the period under review, transcripts of four interviews were open to scholars and researchers for consultation, bringing the total number of finalised transcripts to 977. The names of the interviewees and a brief summary of their reminiscences are given below:

Freedom Fighter and Congressman from Sialkot, Punjab, Pakistan.

### **REPROGRAPHY SECTION**

During the period under review, the work of Quality control of Old Microfilms. In all, the division prepared approx. 35 Rolls on Positive Microfilm rolls to supply to the Hindustan Times. Accessioned around 509 Microfilm Rolls and checked approx 4,76,640 negative Microfilm frames. Rewashed approx 1200 Microfilm Rolls & rewinded approx 1780 rolls of master negative such as Hindustan Times, Janta, Aaj, ABP, Aakhshvani, Advocate, Abhyudya & Ainaa, etc. Sequencing of approx 3435 Microfilm Rolls was done.

Approx. 20,407 microfilm scanned images in CD/DVD for supply to individual scholars, various institutions, All PM museum and also for the use of the different section of the NMML. Approx. 98,198 Photostat copies and 3610 scanned documents have been generated for supply to various divisions of our organization, 23 scholars were attended to meet their demands of various types of Reprographic services. Around 25 posters were designed during the period. The division also covered around 17 events of various seminars and official functions held in-office from time to time.

## **PRESERVATION SECTION**

During the period under review approx 1950 sheets were given tissue pasting, approx 7077 books/files given for fumigation treatment, binding & repairing of approx 1822 books of the Library, 1632 sheets were given lamination treatment, approx 4654 documents were given full pasting, guard removal of approx 2464 documents, cutting of approx 23000 folder, documents & slips, checking and patch removal of approx 130734 archival papers, stitched 11 parcels of CD/DVD and documents. Gather stitching of 1035 gathers and flatting of 1511 documents. Prepared 20 polyester albums with approx 1054 photographs.

#### DIGITISATION

The NMML started Digitization of Manuscripts, Photographs, Books, Journals, Newspapers etc. of the Library and Manuscripts sections in-house with two Zeutschel OS 14000 scanners from July 2020 onwards at Library Annex Basement. Following are the details of resources digitised so far:

The Photographs and PM Museum Collection is scanned at 600 DPI and the rest of the data is scanned at 300 DPI. All data is stored as RAW TIFF files with Photos converted to CLEAN/ACCESS JPEGs and Manuscripts, Books and Newspapers to accessible PDFs.

#### HINDI UNIT

#### **Progressive use of Hindi**

The work relating to the implementation of the Official Language Policy in the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library, is being looked after by the Hindi Unit. The Departmental Official Language Implementation Committee of the Organisation is constituted under the Chairmanship of the Director, NMML.

During the period under review, the Hindi Unit organised three Hindi Workshops on "Rajbhasha Hindi aur Hum", "Sarkari Karyon mein Hindi ka Prayog", and "Vaishvikaran ke Pariprekshay mein Hindi". Also three meetings of the Official Language Implementation Committee were held on 09 September 2020, 05 November 2020 and 15 March, 2021.

In compliance with the directions of the Department of the Official Language, 'Hindi Samaroh' was organised from 14<sup>th</sup> September to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020 in the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library. During this period, various competitions like Essay writing, Noting/Drafting, Translation, Planetarium Walk (Nehru Planet.), Poetry Recitation, Hindi workshop and other programmes were organized for the employees of the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library with the aim to promote and encourage the use of Hindi Official Language in day-to-day official work of the institution. In all, 47 prizes were distributed to the winners.

#### NEHRU PLANETARIUM

The Planetarium was open for public from 1st November, 2020 to 31st march, 2021 due to the prevailing pandemic situation. During the period under review, approximately 25,000 visitors

purchased the Sky Theatre tickets and viewed the Planetarium shows. In addition to the regular public shows at 11:30 AM, 1:30 PM, 3 PM and 4 PM, the planetarium conducted additional public shows on Sundays and during seasonal rush.

The Planetarium conducted various online activities in the period April 2020 - March 2021. The details of all activities is listed as follows:

# **ONLINE PROGRAMS & LECTURES**

- A Skynet Telescope Hangout was conducted on 15th April, 2020 for students interested in Astronomy to take up various online projects offered by various institutes across India. Students were informed and guided how they can take up the projects and also guided them about enrolment process. It was also supported by video lectures by eminent guests. This session was replicated every week in the month of April and May 2020.
- **DOOR STEP ASTRONOMY:** Planetarium initiated this online astronomy education and outreach initiative program during the lockdown period. Various sessions on Youtube and Facebook were conducted for school, graduate and post graduate students. The list of programs is as follows:
  - Planetarium shared informative videos on astronomical sightings of Super Pink Moon on 7th -8th April and the ISS sighting on 9th April 2020 on Youtube and Facebook.
  - Planetarium shared some recorded lectures of eminent personalities in the field of astronomy with school and college students throughout April, 2020.
  - A Youtube Live session was conducted on 21st April, 2020 on the topic "Sundials" by Dr. N. Rathnasree, former Director, Nehru Planetarium.
  - An online talk on the topic "Astronomy in times of Corona" was delivered by Dr. N. Rathnasree, former Director, Nehru Planetarium on 11th May, 2020.
  - A Youtube Live session was conducted on 20th May, 2020 on the topic "Radio Astronomy" by Prof. Divya Oberoi.
  - Planetarium in collaboration with Collins Learning organized a webinar on astronomy on 22nd June, 2020. During the webinar many readily available online astronomy based tools were discussed to help all the participants to get acquainted with the sky stars, constellations and the visibility of the planets and other solar system objects.
  - A Youtube Live session was conducted on 31st August, 2020 on the topic "Journey through the Stars" by Dr. N. Rathnasree, former Director, Nehru Planetarium for a beginners group of amateur astronomers.
- A session titled "Celestial Hide and Seek" was conducted by Dr. Rathnasree with moderating inputs from amateur astronomers Ms. Varsha Gautam, Shri Atish Aman, Shri Abhinav Singhai, Shri Sneh Kesari and Shri Ajay Talwar who had imaged the solar eclipse of the 20th June, 2020 on 5th July, 2020 through online means for school and college students.

- Dr. Rathnasree gave an online talk "Fun with Positional Astronomy" on the 8th October, 2020 for All India People's Science Network and Bharatiya Jana Vigyan Vedica as a part of their World Space Week celebrations.
- On September 16th, following the exciting discovery of Phosphine in the atmosphere of Venus, a session titled "Venus Unveiled" was organised for school students, to place in perspective the nature of this discovery and what it means vis-a-vis the possibility of microbial life in the clouds of Venus. Live inputs were obtained from Prof. Sujan Sengupta, IIA, Bangalore and Dr. Tripti Kumari, Gargi College. Recorded inputs were obtained from Prof. Sanjay Limaye, University of Wisconsin-Madison and Prof. Umesh Khadane, IIST, Thiruvananthapuram, and were included in the session.
- **Interdisciplinary Forum:** Under this stream online discussion programs to enunciate the astronomical usage of the instruments of the Jantar Mantar observatories of India were conducted. These sessions looked into all the details of each and every instrument of the extant Jantar Mantar observatories of India. Astronomy inputs from the point of view of Usage, Restoration and Maintenance were discussed. The intention being the creation of useful resources in all these directions. Following sessions were conducted in this series:
  - On 12th August, 2020 a talk on Youtube Live sessions was organized on "Calendrical Astronomy" by Dr. T. V. Venkateswaran, Vigyan Prasar, Department of Science and Technology. The talk was a walk through the astronomical connections of various calendars with a particular emphasis on the Indian context.
  - A talk on "Planetary Conjunctions in stone inscriptions and Indian Astronomy texts" by Dr. B. S. Shylaja, Jawaharlal Nehru Planetarium, Bengaluru on the 19th December, 2020 was conducted.
  - On 30th September, 2020 in connection with the Jantar Mantar observatories including Astronomy and Architecture inputs, a discussion session was organized by Dr. Rathnasree in conversation with Prof. Barry Allen Perlus, Cornell University.
- Astro-Adda: Nehru Planetarium and The Public Outreach and Education Committee, Astronomical Society of India initiated an online series of lectures called "Astro Adda" consisting of Astronomy lectures with discussions on possible quantitative projects and follow-up interactive sessions. These sessions were conducted as Youtube Live lectures and followed through with whatsapp interactions in a group, with the participants, moderated by the planetarium. Following lectures were conducted in this series:
  - On the 18th July, 2020, the first talk in this series was given by Dr. Priya Hasan, MANUU, on the topic, "GAIA: The Milky Way Mapper". # Annular Solar Eclipse of 21st June, 2020:

Planetarium organised a number of webinars to create awareness about the annular solar eclipse of 21st June, 2020:

- Astronomy Webinar on the 10th June, 2020 on the topic "Let's understand Solar eclipses" for school students was conducted by amateur astronomers Shri Anurag Pandey and Shri Tanmay Vyas wherein various aspects of eclipses and methods for safe observations as well as previous projects undertaken by students during eclipses were discussed.
- On 13th, 19th and 20th June 2020 webinars on the annular solar eclipse was conducted by Dr. Rathnasree. Various aspects of this eclipse, possibilities for safe observations and possible measurement oriented projects were discussed.
- On June 14, 2020 Dr. N. Rathnasree, was invited to speak on Annular Solar Eclipse of June 21, 2020 by Chhattisgarh based Atal Bihari Vajpayee Trust, Abhav Foundation through Zoom interaction with the participants.
- On June 16th, 2020, Dr. N. Rathnasree, was invited by The New Government Polytechnic, Patna by video conferencing to talk on the Annular Solar eclipse.

• Regional Science Centre, Bhopal invited Dr. N Rathnasree to be part of their online Science lectures on Eclipse and its types which was attended by interested participants.

# IN SEARCH FOR COMET NEOWISE:

The month of July in 2020 presents us with once in a couple of hundred generations opportunity to gaze at the Comet namely C/2020 Neowise which has an orbit of about 6700 years around the sun. The comet was visible from NCR for about a couple of weeks in the latter half of July at a magnitude of 1.6 which will go up to 4.0 by the 22nd of this month. The Planetarium conducted various astronomy based activities built around the discussions on Comet Neowise:

- A session on Finding Comet NEOWWISE in the sky was conducted by Dr. Rathnasree and Shri Rishabh Jain, on 17th July, 2020. The session was syndicated by Prasar Bharati, National for their website.
- A special session "Comet NEOWISE : A Ladakh Primer" about the visibility of the comet from the pristine Ladakh skies and discussions of astrophotography efforts from Ladakh moderated by Dr. Rathnasree with inputs from amateur astronomers Ms. Varsha Gautam, Shri Abhinav Singhai and Shri Kartik Jayshankar was conducted on 18th July, 2020 through online means. The session was syndicated by Prasar Bharati, Ladakh for their website.
- A session titled "Comet C2020 F3 NEOWISE from Indian skies" was conducted by Dr. Rathnasree on 19th July, 2020 through online means with moderating inputs from amateur astronomers across the country - 1. Shri Gautam Deka from Mangaldai, Assam, 2. Shri Malay Patra from Jaipur, Orissa, 3. Shri Nihar Patnaik from Berhampur, Orissa, 4. Shri Nikunj Rawal from Jamnagar, Gujrat, 5. Shri Narendra Gor from Bhuj, Gujrat, 6. Shri Alok Mandavgane from Bhopal, MP and 7. Shri Kartik Jayashankar from Jilling Estate, Uttarakhand.
- The Planetarium staff made successful attempts to catch a glimpse of Comet Neowise on 17th July, 2020 from Pataudi, District Gurugram, Haryana using in-house equipment like Telescopes and Binoculars.

# Great Conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn of the 21st December, 2020:

The rare celestial event was celebrated through a number of activities by the planetarium:

- Samanta Chandrasekhar Challenge (SCC): Planetarium initiated and benchmarked a rigorous hands on project for interested participants naming it as the SCC. The call for this was then given nationwide by the Astronomical Society of India, with a large collaboration including ours, asking interested participants to measure the changing angular separation between Jupiter and Saturn, in the three weeks leading to the conjunction, with their handmade crosstaff an inspiration drawn from the 19th century Siddhantic astronomer Samanta Chandrasekhar of Orissa. Very enthusiastic participation was mentored by the planetarium in this challenge which allowed participants to arrive at their own estimation of the conjunction angular separation without any sophisticated equipment or telescopes.
- Telescope Skywatch and webcasts: Planetarium staff undertook observations of the approach to the conjunction from Pataudi in Haryana on the 19th Dec. and public skywatch with telescopes

from Teen Murti lawns on 20th, 21st and 22nd Dec.. The live feed from these observations were included in web sessions conducted on the planetarium Youtube channel on these days.

The webcast conducted on the 21st was syndicated by DD National and the total viewership on our channel and that of syndication crossed 1 lakh views.

• Dr. Rathnasree gave a talk for the Nehru Science Center, Mumbai for their Facebook channel, on the Great Conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn, on the 14th December, 2020.

#### Accounting Policies and Notes to Accounts for the Financial Year Ended 31.03.2021

The Nehru Memorial Museum and Library (NMML) was established on 01.04.1966 under the Societies Registration Act, 1860. The NMML is primarily a research institution and is engaged in the research work of high order in Social Sciences – particularly Modern Indian History and to establish, maintain and run Museum and library. It is a non-profit earning, non-manufacturing body and is fully funded by the Ministry of Culture, Government of India. The Accounts of the entity comprise of the accounts of the NMML Society, Modernization Project Fund, Ford Fund and General Provident Fund and Contributory Provident Fund of the Society.

# A. Accounting Policies

### 1. Accounting Convention

The financial statements of the NMML have been drawn up on historical cost convention and have been prepared in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards issued by The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India on accrual basis unless otherwise stated.

#### 2. Use of Estimates

The preparation of Financial Statements requires some estimates which effect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities on the date of Financial Statements and reported amount of Revenue and Expenses during the year. Difference between the actual result and estimates are recognized in the period in which results are known/materialized.

#### 3. Revenue Recognition

- a. Income from sales of tickets and services are accounted for on receipt basis and is net of rebate and discount wherever applicable.
- b. Fee received for Library Membership are accounted for on accrual basis;

- Income from royalty is accounted for on accural basis and based on the terms or relevant agreement and the statement received from the publishers;
- d. Income from investments -
- (i) Interest on interest bearing securities and fixed deposits is recognized on a time proportion basis taking into account the amount outstanding and rate applicable.
- (ii) Interest pertaining to specific/ endowment fund is credited to the respective fund account.

#### 4. Grants-in-aid

Government Grants for revenue are recognized as income to the extent amount has been utilized as expenditure in the Income and Expenditure account. Unutilized amount of grants in aid at the year end is treated as liability and carried to next year.

Government Grants for acquisition of specific fixed assets are credited to Capital fund. Further the amount equivalent to depreciation for the year is transferred to Income & Expenditure account.

### 5. Fund

- The word 'Fund' has been used to denote the intention to keep the balances invested ultimately.
- ii) Corpus refers to funds contributed by the founders with a specific direction that they form part of the corpus of the NMML and is increased/ decreased by the net operating results shown in Income and Expenditure Account (other than surplus, if any transferred to any Reserves or Earmarked Funds).
- iii) Capital Fund represents the value of fixed assets created out of the grants-in-aid.

#### 6. Fixed Assets

Fixed Assets are stated at cost of acquisition less depreciation thereon except for non-depreciable assets.

#### 7. Depreciation

Depreciation on Fixed Assets is provided on Written down Value Method at the rates prescribed under the Income Tax Act, 1961.

#### 8. Investments

Investments are intended to be held till the maturity as per the management policies and are valued at cost.

## 9. Inventories

Inventories of publications, raw microfilms are shown at cost.

**10.** Consumables/Stationary purchased during the year are charged to expenditure during the same year.

## 11. Employees Benefits

Death-cum-retirement Gratuity (DCRG) and accumulated leave encashment benefits of the employee of the organization is on actuarial basis.

## 12. Contingent liabilities

Liabilities, though contingent, are provided for if there are reasonable prospects of such liabilities maturing. Other contingent liabilities, barring frivolous claims, not acknowledged as debts, are disclosed by way of note.

#### Schedule 25: NOTES TO ACCOUNTS

1) There has been shortfall of investment of GPF Fund and CP fund as on 31.3.2021 by Rs.35,14,035/- (Rs. 13409804/- as on 31.3.2020) as compared with the accumulated balance of GP fund and CP fund on that date. The shortfall is mainly on account of minimum interest payable as per the notification of the Central Government on the members' accumulated balance of fund and the interest earned on the investment held in earlier years.

#### 2) Corpus Fund

During the Financial Year 2013-14 Ministry of Culture, Government of India, New Delhi vide letter No.F-9-1/2013-C&M dated 17<sup>th</sup> September 2013 has sanctioned and released a Financial Assistance of Rs.150 Crore (Rupees One hundred and fifty Crore only) as one time Corpus grant to the NMML, for carryingout its activities.

NMML meets all its Annual Capital Grant requirements (including grants for creation of Capital Assets) from interest earned on this corpus amount with effect from 2014-15 onwards.

4) As per the decision of the Executive Committee held on 24-6-2014 on the augmentation of Corpus Fund, the amount as stated below has been transferred from unutilized interest on Corpus Fund to interest apportioned to Corpus Fund as on 31-3-2021 as was done in previous years.

-For the Financial Year 2020-21 (being 50% approx.) Rs. 65,90,276.00

- 5) The Hon'ble Chairman, EC, NMML has Constituted an Investment Committee for the Investment of Corpus Fund of the NMML on September 2020.
- Previous year figures have been regrouped/recast wherever necessary.

- 7) The year-end figures are taken from the source and rounded to the nearest digits.

8) The organization is fully funded by the Ministry of Culture, Government of India by way of Grant-in-Aids. The summarized position of the Grant-in-Aids received and utilized by the organization for the year ending March, 2021 is as Follows:-

# Separate Audit Report of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India on the accounts of Nehru Memorial Museum and Library, New Delhi for the year ended 31 March 2021.

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of Nehru Memorial Museum & Library (NMML), New Delhi as at 31 March 2021, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account for the year ended on that date, under Section 20 (1) of the Comptroller & Auditor General's (Duties, Powers & Conditions of Service) Act, 1971. The audit has been entrusted for the period up to 2023-24. These financial statements are the responsibility of the NMML's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms, etc. Audit observations on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the Law, Rules and Regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects, etc., if any, are reported through Inspection Reports/CAG's Audit Reports separately.

3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

- 4. Based on our audit, we report that:
- We have obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit except for comment to this Report;
- (ii) The Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure/Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the Uniform Format of Accounts approved by the Ministry of Finance.
- (iii) In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by NMML in so far as it appears from our examination of such books except for comment made in the Report.
- (iv) We further report that:
- A. Balance Sheet:
- A.1 Current Assets, Loans and Advances- Rs. 32.46 crore

A.1.1 The above include Rs. 10.15 crore being amount recoverable from the Ministry on account

of gratuity and leave encashment provision made in the account. However, no sanction for payment of above amount from the Ministry was found on record. In the absence of any sanction, showing of this amount as recoverable was wrong. This has resulted in overstatement of Current Assets, Loans and Advances as well as Corpus Fund by Rs. 10.15 crore each.

#### B. General

**B.1** The 'books with publishers' and 'books with NMML' shown in the schedule of Current Liabilities and Provisions (Schedule 7) of Rs. 4.51 lakh and Rs. 7.75 lakh respectively are very old entries. These entries need to be reconciled and after reconciliation these figures may be adjusted in proper head.

**B.2** It is observed that GPF/CPF balances were merged in the main accounts. Since these balances belong to members, the reason for merging these balances in the main account may be clarified. This was also pointed out during last year.

#### C. Grants in Aid

**C.1** NMML received Rs. 27.39 crore from Ministry of Culture during the year 2020-21. It had unspent grants of Rs. 0.10 crore from the previous year. Besides, it had internal receipts of Rs. 0.34 crore during 2020-21. Out of the funds aggregating to Rs. 27.83 crore, it utilized Rs. 27.78 crore leaving an unspent balance of Rs. 0.05 Crore.

**C.2** NMML had received specific grant of Rs. 35.00 lakh from Ministry of Culture during 2012-13 for undertaking activities for commemoration of 150<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Sh. Motilal Nehru. Out of this, NMML could utilize Rs. 17.59 lakh leaving an unspent balance of Rs. 17.41 lakh as on 31.3.2021. Further, as per conditions of sanction, if the grantee fails to utilize the grant for the purpose for which the same had been sanctioned, the grantee would be required to refund the entire amount with interest thereon @ 10 percent per annum. However, NMML could not utilize the fund even after lapse of more than eight years. NMML neither refunded the unutilized grant and interest on it to the Ministry of Culture nor approval of the Ministry has been obtained to carry forward the unspent grant. This was also pointed out in previous SAR.

#### D. Management Letter:

Deficiencies, which have not been included in the Audit Report, have been brought to the notice of NMML through a management letter issued separately for remedial/corrective action.

(v) Subject to our observations in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.

(vi) In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the said financial statements read together with the Accounting Policies and Notes on Accounts and subject to the significant matters stated above and other matters mentioned in Annexure to this Audit Report give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India;

- In so far as it relates to the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Nehru Memorial Museum & Library, New Delhi as at 31 March 2021; and
- b. In so far as it relates to Income and Expenditure Account of the deficit for the year ended on that date.

## 1. Adequacy of Internal Audit System

There is no internal audit wing/cell set up in NMML.

#### 2. Adequacy of Internal Control System

Internal Control System of the organization needs to be strengthened in view of the following:

- (i) NMML neither utilized the special purpose funds released by the Ministry for commemoration of 150<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Sh. Motilal Nehru nor refunded the unspent balance to the Ministry.
- (ii) Investments of GPF/CPF funds were not made as per the prescribed pattern fixed by the government of India.
- (iii)Huge balances were kept in current account and failure to deposit the amount lying in current account in FDRs/short term deposits, led to substantial loss of interest.
- (iv)Fixed Asset Register has not been maintained properly by NMML.
- (v) Investment Register has not been maintained.

#### 3. System of physical verification of fixed assets

- (i) Physical verification of fixed assets had been conducted upto 2019-20.
- (ii) Physical verification of Library books had been conducted upto 2020-21.

#### 4. System of physical verification of inventory

The physical verification of inventory like stationary and other consumable items had been conducted up to 2020-21.

#### 5. Regularity in payment of statutory dues

No payments over six months in respect of statutory dues were outstanding as on 31.03.2021.
