BIO-DATA

SHRI SADASHIV BAGAITKAR (1923-1983)

A freedom fighter, social and political worker, trade unionist and Lok Dal leader in Maharashtra, Sadashiv Bagaitkar was born on 13 November, 1923 at Junnar, district Poona, educated at Junnar and Pune ; left studies to join freedom struggle in 1939; organised youth through Rashtra Seva Dal, 1940-42, worked with underground movement during 'Quit India Movement 1942'; imprisoned for three and a half years from December, 1942; also imprisoned during Emergency and released on January 26, 1977; was actively associated with Goa and Bangladesh Liberation Movements; Chairman and Secretary of Maharashtra unit of the Socialist Party, 1957-60, General Secretary, Hind Mazdoor Panchayat, Member (i) National Committee, Socialist Party, 1960-64; (ii) Business Advisory Committee, Rajya Sabha since August 1980 and (iii) Indian Parliamentary delegation to the 26th Parliamentary Conference in Lusaka, Zambia, in September-October, 1980; represented (a) Samyukta Socialist Party, at Silver Jubilee Session of League of Communists of Yugoslavia held in Belgrade in 1969 and (b) Hind Mazdoor Panchayat at Histatruts Conference held in Tel-Aviv, Israel in November, 1977; attended I.L.O. Conference in Geneva; led a delegation to the U.S.S.R on behalf of Indian Peace Council in September, 1979; Member of Rajya Sabha from 1978 - 1983; died on 5 December, 1983.
