Application for the Scholars in Residence Programme at the PMML

A new fellowship Programme, namely “Scholars in Residence Programme” is being started at PMML under which scholars from India and also overseas (only those with valid Research Visa) will be staying in PMML Campus for Research based academic activities of a 4 to 6 weeks duration.

2. This new Programme will be organized by the PMML’s “Centre for Contemporary Studies” (CCS) like the ongoing Fellowship Programme.

3. The Topic of Research of the Scholar would generally be related to Contemporary Subjects/Issues of relevance to India and finalized in discussion between Scholar & PMML.

4. A “Cottage” has been made ready and earmarked for on-campus accommodation of scholars on a complimentary allotment basis (stay only) for the duration (2 days + approved Duration + 2 Days) of the Programme.

5. Applications will be invited from scholars and academics worldwide. Only those applications will be considered that have been received at least TWO months in advance of the proposed date of commencement of the Programme, and in case of overseas scholars only those possessing a valid Research Visa can apply to join the Programme. Those based in Delhi/NCR would not be eligible to apply, but scholars from the rest of India would be eligible.

Qualifications: Scholars of eminence who have made a significant contribution to the knowledge in their respective fields and preferably have experience of conducting/guiding research.

Duration: Four to Six weeks

6. The tenure and the topic of research would be finalised by mutual agreement between PMML and the scholar. The scholar has to stay on campus in the accommodation provided for the entire period of Fellowship, work on their research and make at least one presentation at PMML relating to the subject of their Research. They have to also participate in all other academic activities of the CCS, PMML.

7. Out of India time during the Fellowship period (limited to Seven days), if requested by a Scholar can be considered on a case-to-case basis and the Fellowship amount would be accordingly adjusted.

8. During the Fellowship period, the Scholars would be given a complimentary membership of the PMML Library and the Archives.

9. The Scholars shall be provided a Fellowship amount of Rs One Lakh (Lumpsum) for a four week period, with a pro-rata increase for a higher period.

10. Selection Process: PMML will seek applications once a year through an open advertisement against which Indians as well as foreigners can apply. The applications would be screened and finalised by a Committee set up for this purpose (**with Joint Director as the Convenor**) with the approval of the Chairman EC.

Interested scholars are required to send their applications after duly filling them along with a write-up of about 2,000 words on the proposed project to be undertaken. The duly filled application form, research proposal and educational as well as professional certificates/documents must be sent in a **single PDF** file to the e-mail id: **fellowship.nmml@gov.in**, **failing which the application is liable to be rejected**. Incomplete and wrong applications will be summarily **rejected**.
